- Recruited 18 players named to the All-Conference team, two Rookies-of-the-Year, one Player-of-the-Year, nine players named to the All-Rookie team, nine players named to the All-Defensive team, and one player selected as the 17th pick in first round of the 1999 NBA draft.
- Coached in twelve post-season tournaments: NCAA in 1995, 1997, 2005, 2007, 2010, and 2011; NIT in 1999 and 2006; CBI in 2008; CIT in 2009 and 2012; WNIT in 2014.
